



CELEBRATION OF RAKSHA BANDHAN BY RAKHI MAKING COMPETITION


To mark the pious bond of brothers and sisters SHDCHE also organized the Rakhi Making Competition for the students of B.Ed & BBA on 30th August 2023.

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POSTER MAKING



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
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STORY TELLING COMPETITION in REGIONAL LANGUAGES

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



POSTER MAKING ON THE THEME “BACK TO SCHOOL”




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Poster Making Competition on Gender Based Violence



Date - 30 November 2023

Participants were provided with art supplies and given a specified time to create posters addressing different aspects of gender-based violence, such as prevention, support, and breaking stereotypes.



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
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FLOWER POT MAKING FROM OLD PLASTIC

Topic: - Shri. SubramaniamBharati's literary work

The Department of education has organized a group discussion on Shri Subramaniam Bharati's literary work on 15th of December 2023. In this activity students of B.Ed. has been participated.

ChinnaswamiSubramaniaBharatiyar (11 December 1882 – 11 September 1921) was an Indian writer, poet, journalist, Indian independence activist and social reformer from Tamil Nadu, India. Popularly known as "MahakaviBharatiyar", he is a pioneer of modern Tamil poetry and is considered one among the greatest of Tamil literary figures of all time.

His numerous works were fiery songs kindling patriotism and nationalism during Indian Independence movement.

Students discussed about the famous poem and other works of Shri SubramaniamBharati. They shared information and achievements of his greatest works namely, KuyilPattu, PanchaliSapatham and Kannan Pattu that were composed during 1912.

Further students discussed Many of his English works were collected in *Agni and Other Poems and Translations and Essays and Other Prose Fragments* (1937). Students listened patiently.

Dr. NeelamSoni, Director of the college also gave the speech on the great efforts and literary work done by C. SubramaniamBharati. At last honorable principal sir, Dr. Jai Bhagwan also shared some great achievements of C. SubramaniamBharati in the field of poems written .

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ROLE PLAY

The significance of active learning is becoming increasingly acknowledged as a way of increasing the involvement, motivation and responsibility of students in higher education. Role-play as a pedagogy has been used in a wide variety of contexts and content areas. Essentially, it is the practice of having students take on specific roles, usually ones in which they are not familiar and act them out in a case-based scenario for the purpose of learning course content or understanding “complex or ambiguous concepts”. Thus role playing is also used as a teaching pedagogy at RNB Global University.

A Role Play Competition for the students of BBA named "Manager play" was conducted. An assorted group of students was formed, each group was having a combination of BBA II semester, BBA IV semester. Each group was given a particular topic on which they had to perform the role play. The topics comprised of domain related concepts of marketing and HR. Students enacted roles of National Sales Manager, Regional Sales Manager, Salesperson for door to door selling, HR manager conducting interview, student as interviewees for internship to name a few. A narrator aided the transition of scenes from one to another, not to miss the use of slides as backdrop for various scenes. Students performed enthusiastically and showcased their talent, creativity along with their managerial skills.

- Analyze problems from various perspectives
- To apply their knowledge to a given problem, to reflect on issues and the views of others
- Trying various solutions in a case scenario
- Developing team-work, co-operation and creative problem solving in groups
